

MKCPS Creative Digital Competition Rules

1. The Creative Digital competition is separate from the internal league competitions, the annual open competition, and all external competitions. It is intended to encourage the creative use of digital manipulation techniques. "Straight" photographic images should not do well in this competition, even if they are of a very high standard.
2. The competition subject is open.
3. Only PDI entries will be accepted.
4. The maximum number of entries is limited to three per author.
5. Entries must conform to Rules 18 & 19 of the MKCPS Internal Competitions Rules for the submission of entries.
6. Images will be judged by an external judge appointed by the Competition Secretary.
7. The copyright of all parts of the final image must be held by the author. No use is to be made of 'clipart' or third party images. Evidence may be required to show copyright ownership or computer enhancement.
8. This competition is for you to get creative - manipulation of images is a must, but any images or textures etc must be your own.
9. You may only use effects / brushes you have created.
10. You are allowed to use the effects / bushes that come built into the software you are using, but not any you may have purchased and added to the software.
